History of the Sokol

"Not a glorious past but an active, energetic present is a guarantee of the nation's future."

The word Sokol is filled with deep significance to the students of history. Sokol, in the Czech language means a falcon, a bird noted for its swiftness of flight, and symbolic of activity and freedom. It was, therefore, a fitting name and emblem for an organization whose motives are to develop physically and mentally each one of its members.

Over seventy-five years ago a new national consciousness began to arouse patriotic leaders of the Ancient Kingdom of Bohemia. It was then that Dr. Miroslav Tyrs, professor of Esthetics at the University of Praha was inspired with the idea, that the future of the nation depended upon its being physically and morally fit to survive. A carefully planned gymnastic organization if it could include a majority of the population would result in a strong and courageous nation. The Gymnastic Union of Praha founded in 1862 was the forerunner of the Sokol Union of Czechoslovakia which has reached out into the western world and founded Sokol societies in every country where there are enough Czechs to take up the leadership. In seventy-four years it has grown from sixty-eight members to almost one million.

The present Sokol organization in America was founded in 1865 in St. Louis, Missouri, with sixty-five members. The Chicago Sokol Society was established in 1866 with fifty-nine members; New York in 1867; Cleveland in 1870; Cedar Rapids, Iowa and Detroit, Michigan in 1875. The Sokol idea was growing and in August 1878, the foundation was laid for the National Sokol

Union in Chicago. In 1908 three hundred eleven Czechoslovak units comprised the American Sokol Union.

The first Sokol society in Minnesota was organized in 1882, in St. Paul. In 1906 the ladies auxiliary was formed to the lasting advantage of the American Sokol. Sokol Hopkins was founded that same year. Sokol New Prague and Minneapolis were founded in 1912. In 1915 the District of Minnesota was organized for the purpose of uniting Sokol activities throughout this region.

During the stormy days of the world war, all Sokols responded to the call to arms. Long before the United States entered in the war, many had enlisted in Canada; others joined the United States army in 1917.

After the war, the Sokol Denham was organized and the first field meet was held in New Prague, Minnesota, in 1920.

In 1924, Pine City Sokol Society was organized and during the same

year a beautiful tract of land was purchased at Cross Lake, Pine City, Minnesota, and through tireless efforts of the Sokol Camp Association, a spacious, well-equipped camp building was constructed with bathing facilities and boats.

By the decree of the American Sokol Union the Minnesota district was changed to the Northern District of the American Sokol Union on the 16th of April, 1927, and comprised at that time Sokol societies in St. Paul Minneapolis, Hopkins, Pine City and Meadowlands in Minnesota, Mandan North Dakota and Phillips, Wisconsin.

During the year 1928 Lankin, North Dakota, Sokol Society was organized and in 1930 the Cadott, Wisconsin, Sokol Society was taken in the American Sokol Union, followed one year later, in 1931, by the Haugen, Wisconsin, Sokol Society.

Every six years an international meet of all Sokols is held at Praha,




