TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETING:

Whereas, in pursuance of the ACT OF CONGRESS, approved September 28th, 1850, entitled "AN ACT GRANTING BOUNTY LAND TO CERTAIN OFFICERS AND SOLDIERS WHO HAVE BEEN ENGAGED IN THE MILITARY SERVICE OF THE UNITED STATES," warrant No. 98,449 for 40 acres,

issued in favor of

*Orndell Chapman, widow of Elijah Chapman, Private in Captain Barrett's Company, Massachusetts Militia, War of 1812*

has been returned to the **GENERAL LAND OFFICE**, with evidence that the same has been duly located upon the *North west quarter of the North west quarter of section twenty three, in Township thirty-eight North, of Range twenty-one West, in the District of Lands subject to sale at Stillwater, Minnesota, containing forty acres*

according to the OFFICIAL PLAT of the Survey of the said LAND returned to the General Land Office by the SURVEYOR GENERAL, which has been assigned to *Deer W. Johnson* Now know ye, That there is therefore GRANTED by the UNITED STATES unto the said *Deer W. Johnson*

the Tract of LAND above described; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of LAND, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said *Deer W. Johnson*, and to his \_\_\_\_\_ heirs and assigns forever.
