Clype & they had 2 children,
a boy who lives in Fargo & a
daughter who lives in New Jersey.
Marshall was employed by the
Lard & Lakes Creamery for 21 years
until the time of his death in 1957.

Smith. At age four they moved to
the Meadowlark area, where her

father had built a home. Myrtle
married Ed Unserzagt Oct 4, 1930

& they continued to farm the Smith
place until 1948 when Myrtle
passed away & the farm was sold

to John & Anna Grover. Myrtle & Ed
had one daughter, Doris, who is

now married to Gene Vetterling &
they reside in Mpls. They had two
daughters & one grand daughter.

Ed was born July, 23, 1900, at

Moore, Tex & moved to the Pine City
area in 1914. He attended school

in the school house that has
since been moved into Pine City.
