Editor The Pine POKER: The times are not perfect and it's better to say "As we show, so shall we reap."

Many thousands of farmers went broke in the last 2 years and many thousands more cannot meet their obligations on account of high taxes.

What is the remedy? Make laws and let every official and laman obey them as they were given on Mount Sinai. Then every one will be safe in this open bar year. They will then beat their swords into plowshares and their spears into pruning hooks and nation will not war against nation any more.

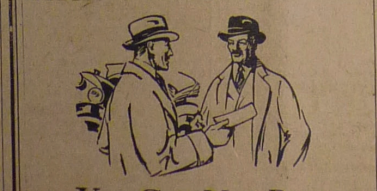
