1 A Wave for Friends-Cuban refugees waved to Cuban exiles on shore as their coast guard cutter approached Key West last fall. Such emotional scenes occurred frequently after Castro announced his "open door" policy, allowing certain groups of Cubans to leave his dictatorship.

Schirra and Stafford rode their red-hot craft back to earth the following day, but Gemini 7 completed a 14 -day mission before its re-entry. Making the longest and most significant voyage in space in Gemini 7 were Frank Borman and James Lovell, Jr.
