Whereas the Towns of Pine and Chengwatana, in Pine County, have duly voted for a bridge over Chengwatana Dam, to cost six hundred(\$600) Dollars, one half to be paid by the Town of Chengwatana, and the other half by the Town of Pine, travel as soon as

Resolved, that the Town of Chengwatana, through its Board of Supervisors, enter into a contract with Adolph Munch, for the construction of a bridge on what is known as Chengwatana Dam, said bridge to be built by said Munch and opened for travel as soon as practicable; said town to pay therefor the sum of three hundred(\$300) dollars, and that the Chairman and Clerk be and they are hereby authorized to execute the following contract with said Munch for the construction of said Dam, and the payment therefor, viz:

"THIS AGREEMENT, made this 24<sup>th</sup> day of March, A.D. 1899, between the Town of Chengwatana and the Town of Pine, in Pine County, Minnesota, (by their respective Boards of Supervisors) parties of the first part, and Adolph Munch, of St. Paul, Minnesota, party of the second part, -

WITNESSETH: That whereas said Towns, and each of them, have duly voted at town meetings and by their respective Boards of Supervisors, to have a bridge built for them over Changwatana Dam,

Now Therefore, in consideration of the construction and erection by said Munch of a bridge 257 feet long and Twelve feet wide, suitable for teams and foot passengers, we agree to pay him therefor, when the same is open for travel, the sum of Six Hundred(\$600) Dollars, the Town of Chengwatana to pay one half thereof, or \$300, and the Town of Pine to pay the other \$300.



Said Munch ~~agrees~~ hereby agrees to erect and construct said bridge in a businesslike manner; that work thereon shall commence by the 27<sup>th</sup> day of March A.D. 1899, and that said bridge shall be completed and open for travel as soon as practical thereafter.
